## HOW TO SORT WASTE



### PAPER AND CARDBOARD

**YES** Newspapers, newspapers, magazines, small cardboard and paper packaging, books and notebooks, paper and cardboard sheets, Tetra Pak food and beverage containers (milk cartons, juice boxes).

**NO** Dirty and/or greasy and oiled paper, used paper towels, plasticized paper, cellophane and plastic bags, Styrofoam.



### ORGANIC

**YES** Food scraps, fruits and vegetables, rotten food without packaging, egg shells, coffee grounds and tea filters, old bread, leaves, cut flowers, plants, paper towels, napkins, used paper towels and tissues, corks, extinguished wood ashes in modest amounts.

**NO** Anything that is not of plant and animal origin, and especially food packaging: trays, cans, nets, bags, cellophane, plastic plates and cups, liquid waste, cigarette butts, shells or mollusk shells, bones.



### PLASTIC

**YES** Plastic bottles, jars, and cans, detergent bottles, plastic bags and pouches, plastic food packages and bags (pasta, chips, candy, etc.) or Styrofoam egg nets, fruit and vegetable nets, snack boxes, plastic jar lids, clean disposable plastic plates and cups.

**NO** Plastic cutlery, hazardous flammable containers, hard plastic and rubber items (pens, markers, toothbrushes, cassettes and CDs/DVDs), garden furniture, buckets, basins.



### GLASS AND METAL

**YES** Glass bottles, glasses and pitchers, glass jars, jars and cans for food preservation, beverage cans, crown caps and capsules, aluminum food trays and foils.

**NO** Ceramic or porcelain objects, crystal waste (glasses or vases), light bulbs, neon, mirrors, bars and other iron materials, metal containers.



### MIXED WASTE

**YES** All non-recyclable materials including rubber, rags, ceramics, porcelain, household dust, earthenware, carbon or oiled paper, diapers and sanitary napkins, CDs, DVDs, pens and markers, vacuum cleaner bags, toothbrushes, pantyhose, plastic razors, plastic cutlery, litter (dogs and cats).

**NO** Recyclables, liquids, improper hazardous materials, rubble, tires.

## WASTE DISPOSAL METHODS

For households in the **town center**, waste should be placed near their homes, using the **provided containers**, from **6am to 8:30am** on the collection day, and **by 6am** for households in the **districts** and **S.S. 113**.

**The use of black bags is prohibited** and it is recommended not to mix waste types. In case of non-compliance, waste will not be collected and a penalty will be risked.



## DON'T YOU HAVE THE CONTAINERS?

If you are not in possession of the waste collection kit, which is provided on loan for free use, it is essential as well as **mandatory** to make a special request for it and proceed to pick it up. It is not possible to deliver waste in the absence of said kit. On the other hand, if one or more of your containers has been stolen, report it to the dedicated number.



### EXHAUSTED BATTERIES

Batteries should be placed in the appropriate containers at offices and stores.



### EXPIRED MEDICINES

Medications go in the containers installed at pharmacies.
